LETTER FROM OUR CEO

Dear Friends of The Women's Center,

Coming out of our 50th anniversary celebrations, we were met with a year that reminded us just how important our work is. The world around felt heavy, marked by layoffs, instability, and tragedy. Here in the DC region, so close to the national center, that weight has been hard to ignore. As a result, the need for mental health services has only increased. Rates of anxiety, depression, and isolation have climbed. And through it all, we kept showing up to serve.



Every year, we push ourselves to reach more places and more people who are underserved. Our new *It Takes a Village* maternal health program has allowed us to connect with pregnant and postpartum Virginians across the state, including rural communities in western and southern Virginia, where the gap in mental health providers is significant. We also launched a new *Resident/Supervisee Training Program* in 2025, investing in the next generation of behavioral health workers and helping close that gap.

2025 also marked my fifth anniversary with The Center. Together, we have navigated a global pandemic, social unrest, the Great Resignation, and ongoing workforce shortages. Through it all, The Center has remained a steady source of healing and hope.

We could not do this work alone. Thank you to our loyal donors and sponsors, whose generosity has kept our doors open through the toughest times, and to our community partners, who continue to stand beside us. Thank you also to our incredible staff, who bring mission and passion to this work every day, our amazing volunteers, who show up for us again and again, and our dedicated Board of Directors, truly the best Board I have had the privilege to work with. We are grateful for this wonderful community.

CLIENT STORY



Paul* came to us struggling with intense anxiety and regular panic attacks. Like many men who seek support, he was initially guarded, not quite ready to open up about what was beneath the surface.

Over time, as trust grew between Paul and his therapist, something shifted. He began to share more openly about a difficult relationship with his elderly mother, the grief of losing his sister, and patterns in his relationships he hadn't fully examined before. Slowly, the walls came down.

Together, they focused on practical skills for managing anxiety, becoming more mindful, and learning to pause instead of react. That work paid off. Paul recently felt confident enough to reduce his sessions to once a month, trusting himself to regulate his emotions and apply the tools he has built through therapy.

2025 HIGHLIGHTS



Launched a Clinical Resident/Supervisee Training Program

In July 2025, we launched our Resident & Supervisee Training Program, modeled after our highly successful student training program. It offers graduate-level therapists working toward licensure a strong foundation and hands-on experience, helping them grow into skilled, compassionate clinicians.



New Maternal Mental Health Program

Also launched in 2025, the 'It Takes a Village' program is a statewide initiative providing mental health support to pregnant and postpartum Virginians. Sessions are offered virtually or in person, at little to no cost.



Expanded Outreach to Men

In 2025, we deepened our commitment to inclusive care by expanding outreach to men, building on the messaging introduced during our brand refresh. We refined how we communicate that The Women's Center serves men, women, and families alike, and worked to reduce stigma through targeted community awareness efforts, ensuring more men know that support is available to them too.

Our Services



INDIVIDUAL & FAMILY COUNSELING: 1,551 community members received 19,006 hours of individual, couples, and family mental health counseling. 59% received reduced fees/free services with 83% of these clients reporting improved mental health.



DOMESTIC VIOLENCE & SEXUAL ASSAULT SERVICES: 464 domestic violence survivors received 6,412 hours of free crisis intervention, mental health counseling, advocacy, and support resulting in 96% of these clients reporting enhanced safety; 94% improved mental health; and 92% reported feeling less isolated.



EDUCATION & CAREER ENRICHMENT: 606 community members received 1,158 hours of affordable financial education, career services, wellness webinars, and mediation services. 90% of these clients reporting that the information they received helped them gain confidence in their skills to find paid work, achieve financial stability, navigate complicated legal processes, and improve work-life balance.



INFORMATION & REFERRAL SERVICES: We provided 7,465 callers with important information, including vital information about programs for children and teens, suicide prevention, behavioral and mental health, career programs, domestic violence, sexual assault, among others.

CLIENT STORY



When Val* first began counseling at The Women's Center in early 2025, she was navigating the lasting effects of childhood trauma, unhealthy past relationships, and the uncertainty of homelessness. Although committed to healing, she was hesitant to revisit painful experiences that often left her feeling overwhelmed by difficult memories and emotions.

Throughout the year, Val demonstrated remarkable resilience and determination. She attended every counseling session, actively advocated for the resources she needed, and remained focused on building a future that would not be defined by her circumstances. Through counseling, she gained a deeper understanding of how trauma had shaped her reactions and emotions, helping her approach challenges with greater self-compassion and confidence.

While her healing journey was still unfolding at year's end, Val had already begun to develop a new perspective on her experiences, recognizing her strength and capacity for growth.

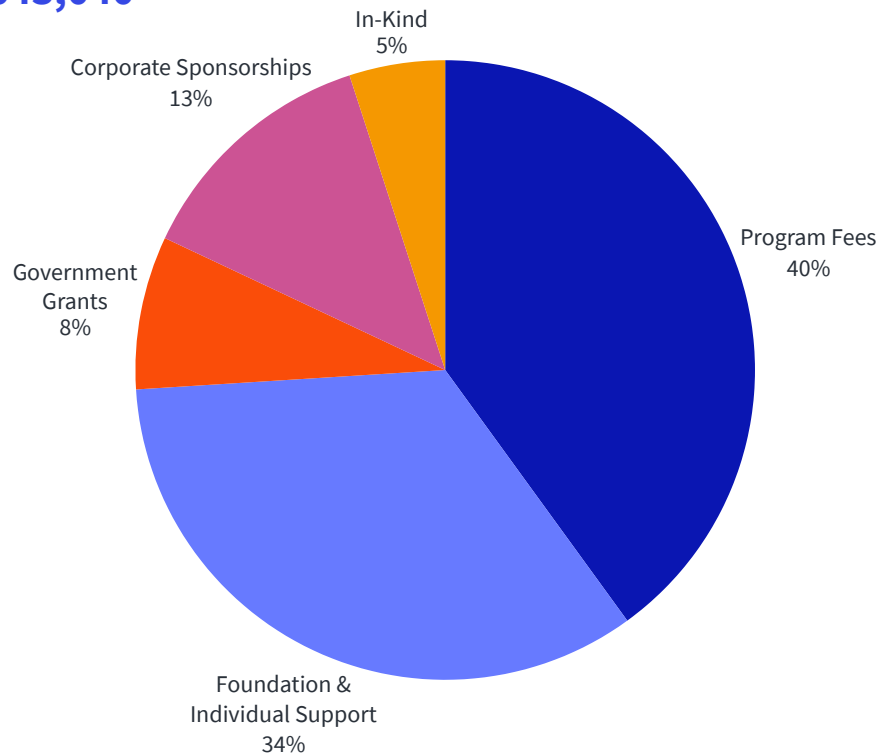

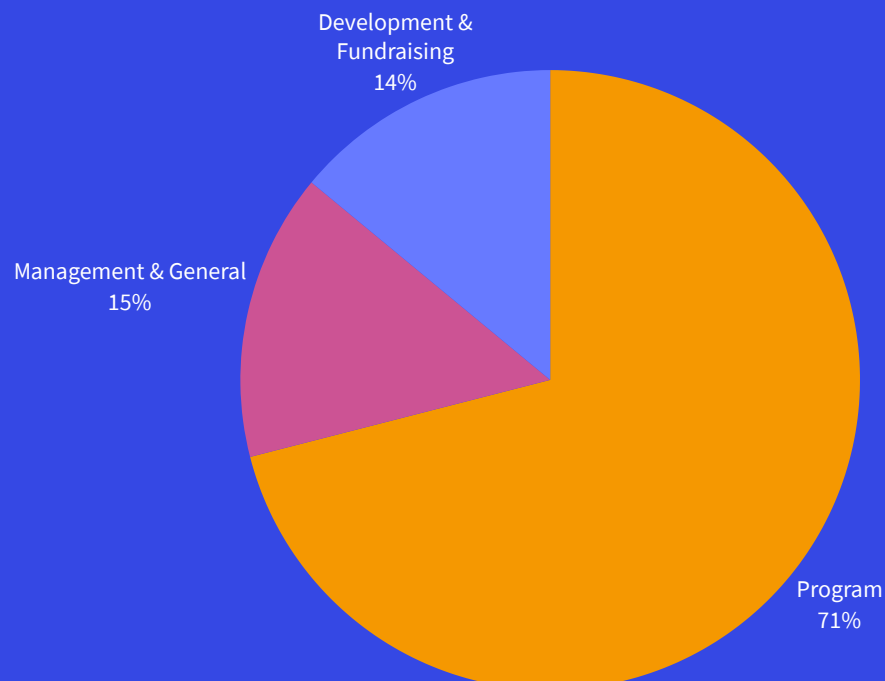
